When Ted lost the job he had held for 17 years and his house went into foreclosure not long after that, it was almost an anticlimax. After all, his wife and children had already left him and he could not remember ever being anything but deeply in debt.

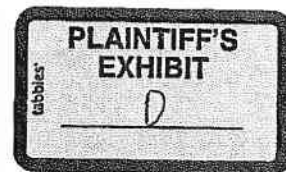
Then he heard about the Narconon outpatient drug rehab program in Clearwater.

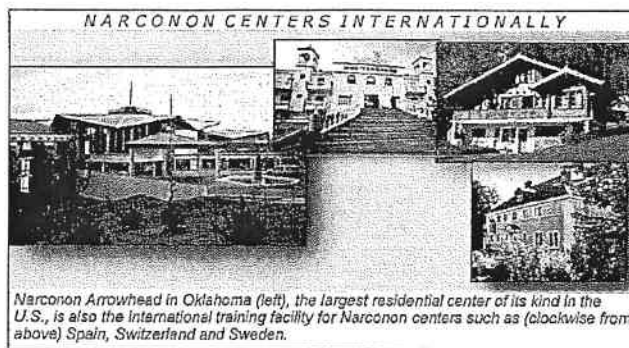

The Narconon Clearwater program was recently reviewed by Dr. Betty Buchan, Vice President of Research at Operation PAR, an addiction research and treatment program located in five counties of the Tampa Bay area. In her position, Dr. Buchan evaluates different types of methods for substance abuse treatment in the Tampa Bay community.
